RE: School Reorganization Team - Meeting Summary #5

This meeting of the School Reorganization team focused on obtaining feedback and input on the potential school reorganization models.

As a first step in gathering feedback on the current school reorganization models, and other models that might exist, the team spent time engaged in an LBLB Protocol.

All team members were given uninterrupted quiet time to capture their thoughts on a graphic organizer with both sentence frames already listed. They look like this:

During the uninterrupted quiet time, the team filled out as many sentence frames as they wanted so that they could capture and organize their thoughts. The focus was on why they like a particular model; not why they do not like a particular model.

Once everyone had uninterrupted quiet time, each group was given the opportunity to share their LBLB statements. Even though the sharing was done by group, individuals shared their LBLB statements one at a time. As a reminder, the representative groups are:

- Certificated Employees
- Classified Employees
- Parents of Elementary Students
- Parents of Secondary Students
- Site Administrators

While individuals shared by group, everyone else listened to the LBLB statements from others on the team. Commenting judging or critiquing, someone else's LBLB statement(s) was not permitted.

There are no right or wrong LBLB statements, these are opinions and thoughts and we value everyone's opinion and thoughts and respect them as such.
