The 0 period is provided so that your child can remain in DLI but also have an elective choice. You would need to contact site administration about this option. Mid-year schedule changes are not advised.	
I feel that the parents & kids need a tour of the school. Also, I feel that a meeting for the parents as well as a meeting for the kids to be able to give them information	We have 4 DLI meetings but are happy to hold an additional meeting. Additionally, each principal is holding a coffee with the principal about middle school.

Parents are interested in GMS hosting an open house where kids could come and find their classes, lockers, library, etc.</p>	<p>On 2/2022, there is a GMS information meeting where families can visit the school and hear more about the middle school program. Additionally, some virtual parent meetings and student tours are being scheduled.</p>	
<p>How many kids are in each class?</p>	<p>At the secondary level, classes can have up to 36 students. In PE, there can be up to 50 students. In DLI, we are waiting to see how many students remain in the program so that we have numbers to share with parents.</p>	
<p>What is best for our students? Should they have 6 periods or 7?</p>	<p>The choice is up to the family. By offering a 0-period PE class, students will have an elective choice. Students who are still classified as EL's must take ELD as an elective.</p>	
<p>Will class schedules change through the semester?</p>	<p>The schedule will not change for the entire year except if your child's elective is the wheel. They will have 3 different classes (STEM, Gladiator Onboarding, and Art). The teacher will change but not the period.</p>	
<p>We would like more counselors in the school and sufficient staffing.</p>	<p>Thank you for this feedback. We will share this with all partners.</p>	
<p>Please share safety measures as we are concerned about safety and security.</p>	<p>The District has allocated GMS 3 full-time campus security personnel for next year. Additionally, each site has a comprehensive school safety plan that will be shared with the community.</p>	
<p>What middle school will have the program?</p>	<p>AUSD is undergoing reorganization this year. Center, Slauson, and Foothill</p>	

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	<p>will close at the end of the school year, and all students will attend the new Gladstone Middle School, which is currently Gladstone High School.</p>	
<p>What other resources are there for students in middle school?</p>	<p>We are providing many middle school supports, such as the WEB (Where Everybody Belongs) program that focuses on service learning, mentorship, school safety, and anti-bullying. To address social-emotional learning, GMS will have Cougar Pals, APU interns, McKinley services, ERMHS, and the Wellbeing Center with on-site counseling services. GMS will also have academic counselors and psychologists to support students.</p> <p>Mr. Perdomo reviews these supports and more in his middle school presentation.
