

## **NUTRITION SERVICES TEST**

The Azusa Unified School District requires that, prior to employment, all Food Service Worker I applicants pass a basic Nutrition Services Test. The test is part of the Azusa Unified School District's screening process, and we hope that the following information will help explain the testing process.

**1. When is the Nutrition Services Test given?**

The test is given once a month **at the District Office of the Azusa Unified School District. Please see the map on the reverse side for the location of the District Office (#18).** You will need to report with a picture identification card, such as a driver's license.

**2. How do I sign up for the test?**

Call Human Resources at (626) 858-6172 for dates and to sign up.

**3. What areas are covered in the Nutrition Services Test?**

The test covers basic food preparation, cleanliness and counting money.

**4. How long is the test?**

The test is approximately one hour long.

**5. How will I be notified of the test results?**

Results will be mailed to you. Please allow two weeks.

**6. If I don't pass the test, may I retake the test?**

You will be allowed to retake the test.

**7. How can I brush up on my basic skills?**

The Azusa Adult School offers adult basic classes. Call (626) 852-8400 to get information about their morning, afternoon and evening classes.

**8. How do I reschedule to retest?**

Call the Human Resources Department at (626) 858-6172.

**9. When I pass the test, how long is my test scores kept on file?**

Your test scores are kept on file and it is unlikely you will have to retake the test at some further date.

A completed application must be submitted before you take the Nutrition Services Test.
